# EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (COVID-19) PROTOCOL (SPECIAL) DIRECTIVE, 2020

## ENTERTAINMENT PROTOCOLS EFFECTIVE MIDNIGHT DECEMBER 30 TO MIDNIGHT JANUARY 6

1. Any person/entity who wishes to host an activity that exceeds 150 persons shall first seek the permission of the Covid-19 Protocol Monitoring Unit and shall comply with such conditions as the Unit may determine.
2. The host of a pleasure cruise shall first obtain the permission of the Unit which shall determine the maximum number of guests that the cruise can accommodate and the conditions and protocols applicable thereto.
3. Every guest attending a pleasure cruise shall wear a face mask.
  - a. Where the host of a pleasure cruise exceeds the maximum number of guests that the cruise can accommodate as determined by the Unit;
  - b. or fails to comply with the conditions or protocols, the cruise is liable to be terminated, the vessel will be ordered to return to shore and the guests ordered to disembark.
4. No group of persons assembling at a beach or a park shall exceed 50 persons and those persons shall observe the physical distancing protocols, unless they are members of the same household.
5. All persons who assemble in public places shall comply with the physical distancing protocols.

**Any person who breaches this directive or fails to comply with any conditions specified by the Unit is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$50 000 or to imprisonment for a term of one year or to both.**
